### STAFF REVIEWED REPORTS WITH COUNCIL

<u>COUNCIL APPROVES CONSENT AGENDA</u> — Council Member Rachelle Ebarb made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda which consisted of minutes from the July 19, 2022 special meeting and the July 26, 2022 regular meeting of the Council. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gary Litton and approved by unanimous vote.

### COUNCIL ADOPTS ORDINANCE 20220823A, SETTING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL

YEAR 2023 – Council Member Kim Smith made a motion to adopt Ordinance 20220823A, thereby setting the budget for Fiscal Year 2023 as presented at both the workshop and the public hearing. The motion was seconded by Council Member Rachelle Ebarb and approved with a unanimous vote.

#### COUNCIL SETS THE MAINTENANCE & OPERATIONS PORTION OF THE 2022 AD

<u>VALOREM TAX RATE</u> – Council Member Rachelle Ebarb made a motion to set the M&O portion of the 2022 ad valorem tax rate at \$0.320000 per \$100 valuation. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gary Litton and passed with a unanimous vote.

### COUNCIL SETS THE INTEREST & SINKING PORTION OF THE 2022 AD

<u>VALOREM TAX RATE</u> — Council Member Twila Bertrand made a motion to set the I&S (or debt coverage) portion of the 2022 ad valorem tax rate at \$0.278996 per \$100 valuation. The motion was seconded by Council Member Kim Smith and passed with a unanimous vote.

### COUNCIL ADOPTS ORDINANCE 20220823B, SETTING THE AD VALOREM TAX

RATE FOR 2022 – Council Member Rachelle Ebarb made a motion to adopt Ordinance 20220823B, setting the 2022 ad valorem tax rate at \$0.598996 per \$100 valuation. The motion was seconded by Council Member Keith Malone and passed with a unanimous vote.

### COUNCIL VOTES TO RATIFY TAX RATE AS SET BY ORDINANCE 20220823B -

Following guidelines set down in Chapter 102 of the Texas Local Government Code, a motion was made by Council Member Kim Smith and seconded by Council Member Rachelle Ebarb to ratify the vote taken to approve the 2022 ad valorem tax rate set forth in Ordinance 20220823B. The motion was approved by a unanimous vote.

COUNCIL ADOPTS ORDINANCE 20220823C, SETTING NEW UTILITY RATES — Due to sharply increasing prices for fuel, utility maintenance parts, and the cost of providing utility and road maintenance services, after discussion and careful consideration of the matter Council adopted Ordinance 20220823C, increasing the monthly minimums for each utility service and slightly increasing the cost of consumption for water, wastewater, and natural gas. Council Member Kim Smith made a motion to approve Ordinance 20220823C which was seconded by Council Member Keith Malone and approved by a unanimous vote.
